

# LONDON CONTROL

## SEPTEMBER 2005 UPDATE AIRAC 10/2005

This update brings the London Control data up-to-date to AIRAC 10/2005 (29 September 2005). It also includes the current version of the program files (version 1.2).

### **Installation:**

If autorun is enabled on your CD-ROM drive, the installation program will run automatically.

If autorun is disabled, choose Start Menu | Run, type d:\Update0510.exe (where d: is the letter of your CD-ROM drive) and press Enter. Follow the instructions that appear on screen.

### **The following data changes have been incorporated:**

#### **AIRAC 7/2005**

New reporting point SUBUK on N864/UN864 between DCS and WAL.  
Scottish Dean Cross South Sector frequency changed from 129.22 to 135.52.  
EGCC, EGGP and EGNR inbounds from the south now route via N57/UN57 and T420.

#### **AIRAC 8/2005**

Guernsey (EGJB) STAR GUR2B now routes ANGLO – DIKRO – BEVAV – OYSTA and renamed GUR3B.

#### **AIRAC 9/2005**

LTCC Logan Sector frequency now 135.42.

#### **AIRAC 10/2005**

Birmingham (EGBB) STAR GROVE1D withdrawn.  
London Heathrow (EGLL) runway 23 withdrawn.  
Shannon SHANN Sector frequency now 134.27.

### **Other changes:**

The repetitive flight plan database has been extensively revised, with over 4,000 flight plans added or updated.

A new pilot's voice has been added for North American aircraft operators.

Net Jets Europe's radiotelephony callsign has changed to *Fraction*.

### **Notes:**

All updates are cumulative. This update also contains changes to data and software that have been included in previous updates. Refer to the London Control website for details of previous updates.

The documentation has not been revised for this update, due to the minor nature of the changes. Dates and AIRAC numbers of documents and maps change only when a significant modification is made. The most up-to-date version of a document or map may still relate to a previous AIRAC cycle. Minor changes may not result in documents and maps being revised until a later update.

Data for the Scottish FIR is included on this update CD-ROM, in the folder called *Scottish*. This is the same version as is currently available for download from the London Control website. Run the program *Scottish.exe* to install.
